#### Base Requirement for Papers

10-12 pages or 3000 words  
Double-spaced  
Times New Roman  
Size 12 font

#### Text Format

When preparing your paper, the fewer layout specifications (such as multiple columns, font changes, type size, page parameters, etc) the better. Please use italic, sub- and superscript, and special characters as needed. However, please keep in mind that there are certain limitations to recreating mathematical equations (for example the average symbol, usually denoted by a bar over a figure, is not something we can recreate for the publication).

#### Headings

Please mark headings by one space between the previous paragraph and one space before the paragraph below. Please use sub-headings sparingly.

#### Graphics

Charts and figures MUST be either an .eps file, Adobe Illustrator (.ai) file or in a bitmap format. If the image is a bitmap, acceptable formats are JPEG (.jpg) or TIFF (.tif) files, and they must be at least 300 dpi (600 dpi is preferred). When possible, please include the data used to create a chart. Additionally, please make sure that the charts are clear when printed out in black and white.

#### Citing References and Endnotes
