Interested in events unfolding in Europe or thinking about studying abroad? Join the European Union Center for a program highlighting student experiences in Europe. James Kirchick will kick-off the dinner with a keynote presentation, followed by a panel of students returning from studying in Europe. Panelists will share their personal experiences, discuss what it was like to be in Europe during such an eventful time, and answer your questions.

James Kirchick will discuss his latest book, *The End of Europe: Dictators, Demagogues and the Coming Dark Age*. In this book, he shows us the shallow disingenuousness of the leaders who pushed for "Brexit;" examines how a vast migrant wave is exacerbating tensions between Europeans and their Muslim minorities; explores the rising anti-Semitism that causes Jewish schools and synagogues in France and Germany to resemble armed bunkers; and describes how Russian imperial ambitions are destabilizing nations from Estonia to Ukraine. Kirchick is a visiting fellow in the Center on the United States and Europe and Project on International Order and Strategy at the Brookings Institution.
